
## Olivia O'Connor Carving.

This PDF is to supplement to instructional video on the Carbatec YouTube Chanel, the video is titled: *Beginners Woodcarving. 4 Basic Carving Cuts with Olivia O'Connor.* I was originally taught this pattern by Peter Follansbee, I hope that you enjoy it and pass it on to someone too! In the video I used Pfeil gouges in sizes 15/8 and 7/18, I also used a compass, a square and a sawn-off Phillips head screw driver as a decorative punch. You can use different sized gouges and draw different sized semi-circles to make your pattern smaller or larger to fit your own project. In the video I am carving in Jelutong, but I have also carved the same pattern in oak.

1. Mark out your pattern. The outer circles on mine measured 11.5cm in diameter.



2. Come along with your V-tool and using a running cut, cut out your circular arches.
